Champagne & Sparkling Wines

- 1. Prosecco, Galanti Extra Dry , Italy** (13009) 125ml **£7.00** 750ml **£35.00**
Clean, dry and crisp, with a fruit spectrum of apple, pear and a hint of peach.
- 2. Prosecco Galanti Rosé , Italy** (13010) 125ml **£7.00** 750ml **£38.50**
Light, carnation-pink coloured rose with generous raspberry and strawberry fruit on the nose and palate.
- 3. Prosecco Bottega Gold, Italy** 200ml **£10.50**
Produced with one single fermentation to protect the delicate aromas and freshness of the Glera grape. Luxurious aromas of apples, citrus fruits and white blossom.
- 4. Prosecco Bottega Rosé, Italy** (13012) 200ml **£10.50**
Brilliant sparkling rose that is fresh, harmonious, delicate and persistent. The peach-coloured liquid carries distinct flowery aromas and scents of mixed berries, currants and strawberry.
- 5. Louis Dornier et Fils, Brut , France** (13005M) 125ml **£12.50** 750ml **£46.50**
A light, fresh, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate.
- 6. Bouché Père et Fils Cuvée Réserve Brut** (13001) 750ml **£48.50**
A ripe, biscuity Champagne with a fine mousse and a long, elegant finish. A blend of 50% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier.
- 7. Bouché Père et Fils, Rose , France** (13002) 750ml **£49.50**
Beautiful pale salmon pink in colour, fresh and elegant with red fruit character on the palate.
- 8. Taittinger Brut Reserve NV, France** (13004) 750ml **£75.00**
Light, delicate and elegant; dry, fresh and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character. Produced from first pressings.
- 9. Moët & Chandon, Brut Imperial NV, France** (13005) 750ml **£90.00**
This Champagne has a slight appley, yeatey nose and long, rich flavours of biscuity, toasty fruit.
- 10. Bollinger Special, Cuvée Brut NV, France** (13006) 750ml **£125.00**
Rich, dry and full flavoured. Consistently one of the finest Champagnes.

White Wines

- 11. Chardonnay, Granfort Pays d'Oc, France** (18025) 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
A soft, green apple scented with plenty of fruit on the palate.
- 12. Sauvignon Blanc, Granfort Pays d'Oc, France** (18026) 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
Refreshing aromatic wine, shows notes of apple and tropical fruit.
- 13. Pinot Grigio Corte Vigna delle Venezie, Italy** (18024) 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
Floral, racy and dry with green crisp fruit.
- 14. Flagstone Noon Gun Chenin Blanc-Sauvignon Blanc-Viognier, Western Cape**(14011) 750ml **£39.50**
A blend of about 34% Chenin Blanc, 34% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Viognier and 9% Colombard that delivers intense, aromatic, tropical fruit flavours spiked with a wedge of orange peel and a sprinkling of baking spice.
- 15. Sauvignon Blanc Southern Rivers, N. Zealand** (14014) 750ml **£39.00**
Fresh, grassy-gooseberry Sauvignon Blanc.
- 16. Sancerre, Joseph Mellot, France** (14015) 175ml **£12.50** 250ml **£16.00** 750ml **£45.00**
Stylish and racy, with the classic blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry character.
- 17. Chablis, Vignerons, France** (14016) 750ml **£55.00**
Fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character.
- 18. Picpoul de Pinet, Réserve Mirou, France** (14009) 750ml **£49.00**
Bright and fresh with plenty of citrusy fruit.
- 19. Chardonnay 'Grand Cru' Terre Siciliane, Rapitalà, Sicily** (14013) 750ml **£65.00**
Pale gold in colour, it shows rich, Sicilian fruit reminiscent of honeydew melon and tropical fruits like pineapple and greengage, with notes of vanilla and cream acquired from a period of oak ageing.
- 20. Pouilly-Fumé, La Ralotte, Adrien Maréchal, France** (14008) 750ml **£68.00**
Classic unoaked Sauvignon Blanc from the village of Pouilly-sur-Loire
- 21. Pouilly-Fuissé Les Petites Pierres, Louis Jadot, France** (15022) 750ml **£78.00**
Louis Jadot has five villages Fuissé, Pouilly, Solutré, Vergisson and Chaintré and take immense care in controlling the production and maturation.

Rosé Wines

- 22. Zinfandel Rosé, O & E, California** ⁽¹⁶⁰²³⁾ 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
Light-bodied & sweet, full of summer berry fruit flavour.
- 23. Pinot Grigio Rosato, Viticoltori Ponte, Italy** ⁽¹⁶⁰²²⁾ 750ml **£28.50**
Fresh and youthful off-dry wine that has a lovely rose petal pink colour.
- 24. Portillo Malbec Rosé, Uco Valley, Mendoza** ⁽¹⁶⁰²⁵⁾ 750ml **£28.50**
Highly aromatic with its ruby-red hints, this rosé offers up fruit aromas of cherry, strawberry and raspberry.

Red Wine

- 25. La Campagne Shiraz, Pays d'Oc, France** ⁽¹⁸⁰²⁷⁾ 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
A juicy, youthful red rich wine with a soft, spicy palate.
- 26. Cabernet Sauvignon, La Campagne, France** ⁽¹⁵⁰²⁰⁾ 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
Ripe red, black fruits and oak make up the aroma of this mid-bodied red wine.
- 27. Merlot, La Campagne, France** ⁽¹⁸⁰²⁸⁾ 175ml **£7.50** 250ml **£9.50** 750ml **£28.50**
Soft and juicy with a perfumed red fruit character.
- 28. Côtes du Rhône, La Dentelière, France** ⁽¹⁵⁰¹⁷⁾ 750ml **£39.50**
Deep in colour, showing plenty of dark peppery fruit and a decent grip in the mouth.
- 29. Rioja, Marques de Morano, Spain** ⁽¹⁵⁰¹⁸⁾ 750ml **£39.50**
Soft, juicy red with lots of plum and black fruits flavours.
- 30. Malbec, Mendoza Portillo, Argentina** ⁽¹⁵⁰¹⁹⁾ 175ml **£10.50** 250ml **£14.00** 750ml **£37.50**
A mid-bodied and warming red wine that has a good attack of damson and spice aromas.
- 31. Pinot Noir, Vavasour, Awatere, N. Zealand** ⁽¹⁵⁰²¹⁾ 750ml **£39.00**
Pure and intense black cherry and plum fruit defines this mid-bodied red.
- 32. Barolo, IL Bastione, Italy** ⁽¹⁵⁰²⁵⁾ 750ml **£49.00**
A full bodied red that has plenty of rich fruit to balance the grainy tannins.
- 33. Château Musar, Hochar Père et Fils Red, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** ^(05013D) 750ml **£58.00**
Intense with a complex nose of juicy black and red fruits, fig, date and spice. The palate shows red and black cherry, blackcurrant and damson fruit with fine tannins and a long finish.
- 34. Château Lamothe-Cissac, Haut-Médoc, France** ^(18032G) 750ml **£59.00**
Fine, aromatic, with a ripe cherry character enlivened by liquorice and vanilla.
- 35. Fleurie Poncereau, Louis Jadot, France** ^(15015G) 750ml **£69.00**
Mellow, elegant but also racy, it has a silky texture and plenty of ripe red fruit.

Dessert & Fortified Wines

- 36. Sauvignon Blanc, Errazuriz, Late Harvest, Chile 2010** ⁽¹⁷⁰²⁵⁹⁾ 75ml **£7.50**
A sweet white wine with pronounced floral and citrus aromas.
- 37. Harvey's Bristol Cream Sherry, Spain** 50ml **£4.50**
Deep golden in colour with fragrant aromas of candied orange, dried fruit and toasted almonds.
- 38. Harvey's Club Classic, Amontillado Sherry, Spain** 50ml **£5.50**
Classic medium dry sherry with a golden amber hue. It is smooth, elegant and full-bodied with a woody aroma and nutty flavours.
- 39. Tio Pepe, Very Dry Sherry, Jerez, Spain** 50ml **£5.50**
Refreshingly crisp and dry. Made from fruity Palomino grapes, it is pale straw in colour with alluring almond aromas.
- 40. Cockburn's Fine Ruby Port, Portugal** 50ml **£6.50**
Fine Ruby can be enjoyed on its own but also pairs very well with chocolate desserts and cheese.
- 41. Cockburn's Special Réserve Port, Portugal** 50ml **£7.50**
Delicious Port with which to end a meal, enjoyed on its own or paired with dessert or fine cheese.
- 42. Cockburn's LBV** 50ml **£8.50**
Deep red in colour and with aromas of damson, mulberry, summer fruits and chocolate; it leaves an intense sensation on the palate with some complexity from its wood ageing. The fortified element is well married to the wine presenting a harmonious balanced feel.
